December 18th, 2001 5:45am Tuesday

When Jon left a while ago for work, I saw there was a heavy frost and cold air blew in the door as I hugged him goodbye. Winter feeling...it comes soon.

Earlier, Jon read the daily scripture from Jeremiah. "Behold, the days are coming, says the Lord, when I will raise up a righteous shoot to David." The Psalm response; "Justice shall flourish in his time and fullness of peace for ever." There's a promise we need to hear in our day. The gospel gave the account of the angel coming to assure St. Joseph and encourage him to trust and have no fear to take Mary as his wife.

He was a light to me as he shared that lovely thought. Over the years of friendship with these two individuals, Jesus has embraced me over and over.

I could go on and on... Just coming off a Cursillo as Observer and working in my own team meetings, preparing for Cursillo 194 in February, I have been touched by Jesus over and over. I saw his light in the room last Sunday at team meeting, in each pair of shining eyes.
