The Meanderings of a morning study time...

It's "study time"...after all school is getting ready to start for everyone, right? I'm in two small study groups and finding it amusing how they are twining together like a Morning Glory vine around a tomato plant. Dr. Phil McGraw's "Life Strategies" book winds around Max Lucado's "Just Like Jesus"! I'm glad to be studying these books with friends. It helps me be able to stick with it.

This morning I picked up Doctor Phil's book to see what the first page of Chapter 4, next week's lesson, has to say. Life Law #4 You can't change what you don't acknowledge.

"Your Strategy; Get real with yourself about your life and everybody in it." He's teaching about being a straight shooter with myself and others... Phil is tough reading at 5:30 a.m. Maybe Max will give me a break.

In chapter 4 of Just Like Jesus, Lucado gave a suggestion to open your Bible and read until something hits you, then take some time to meditate on it, perhaps write about it. I know I don't spend enough time with scripture. This could help me!

I'll take a look at today's scripture reading; Peter...there he goes again...getting in trouble in Matt.16:13-23. Peter protested to Jesus! Peter thought it was a big mistake for Jesus to go up to Jerusalem, to the cross, and told Jesus so. Jesus put the hammer down on him, told him to get out of his sight. In essence, Jesus told Peter he was a stumbling block. Jesus said Peter was not judging by God's standards.

With Lucado's homework assignment in mind, it is that phrase that stops me to contemplate..."you are not judging by God's standards". I do that a lot. I don't look at the big picture but at a tiny piece of the puzzle and I trip over that. It may not make sense to me. I'm very sure that God keeps trying to get through to me. Sometimes I "get it" and sometimes I don't. It is somehow comforting that Peter was with the very Messiah himself and often didn't "get it".

That gives me hope for myself as I keep working my way across the prairie of my own life, seeking knowledge and guidance, so to travel the way of harmony and peace. That's what I want. How do I get what I want? That takes some work and discipline, lots of self awareness and understanding of how this girl's mind works, asking myself the 'hard questions' of what I need to learn and do in my daily round to assist myself as I continue the journey. I'm glad I don't have to do it alone.

POST CURSILLO NOTES

Palanca Chapel - is one absolutely essential element of a Cursillo weekend. This is where the fuel for the Cursillo is generated. All of us have benefited greatly from the wonderful self-giving of others. Let's follow their example by making a whole-hearted commitment and follow through. Cursillistas are needed to fill the hours in the Palanca Chapel each weekend. If there is no one to cover the Palanca Chapel then a team member must fill in, which takes them away from other weekend duties. The Palanca chart is available at Buddy Mass or anytime during the Cursillo weekend. You may also sign up by calling Mike Holbrook at 217-223-6676.

Palanca Letters - need to be written to the team and the candidates. These are spiritually and psychologically important. Remember how you

felt when you found out how many people were praying for you. Don't forget to write letters to those you know as well as those you do not know. Please make sure these letters are delivered on Thursday evening or Friday morning if at all possible. Letters are needed for Friday and Saturday. Unless all the candidates and team have letters none will be given out. Candidate and team names are posted in the letter writing room. They are also available from your area representative or board members prior to the weekend.

Palanca - includes prayer, fasting, sacrifices of any kind, and helping out behind the scenes. Remember that prayer and palanca are essential for the success of the weekend. (Please do not bring gifts for the team or candidates, such as flowers, etc.)
