Dear Cursillo Family -

The Board elections are final! The ballots have been counted - again, and again, and again - because they were so very close. There were 271 ballots cast with **Marcia Steinkamp, Mary Dodd, Rob Edwards and John Peterson** being elected to our Board for a three-year term beginning in August. They will be replacing Jana Casper, Jan Faler, Bill Gilmore and Jeff Liesen. I would like to extend a huge thank you to each of them for their service to Jesus, and ask that you continue to keep them and all of your Board members in your prayers.

Your Cursillo Board has made the decision to eliminate all outside entertainment at all meal times each weekend.
