DeColores! The Cursillo Leaders' Manual (page 91) states what Cursillo weekends should accomplish, and is "compared to a new birth, a rebirth in Christ; to a living communication with a community of faith, which is made present through the Communal witness of the leaders". Retreat Center Courtyard

Last month, the 4th Day announced the addition of a new outdoor Stations of the Cross, walking path, benches and flower area to the Retreat Center Courtyard. The Stations of the Cross was the Eagle Project of Chris Meats, son of Terry and Judy Meats. Chris's name was overlooked in last month's newsletter and the editor regrets the error. Under Chris's leadership, the St. Peter's Troop #5 Scouts put in over 200 hours on the project.

Some additional background - The Stations originally hung in St John's Catholic Church in Hunnewell, MO. Cursillista Pat Kendrick had been storing them in her basement when she heard about Chris's project.

The trail was originally designed and made by Fr. Joseph Zimmerman in the '70's when he taught at Our Lady of Angel's Seminary (now the Franciscan Retreat Center.) He had the idea to construct a walkway in the courtyard for prayer and for walking. He planned the trail to be positioned in such a way as to have the sun shining on it at some point each day throughout the winter. Keeping the snow melted, it could be used for meditation and exercise year round.
