From the Lay Director's Notebook

I've been called to be on a team - where do I go? What do I do?

First, and foremost, begin praying – pray as if your life depended upon it for you will be under attack from here on until the weekend is over.

Then encourage your prayer buddies to do likewise, and make sure that one of them will be present to hang your cross on Thursday night of the weekend. It is extremely saddening to hear a team member's name called and see no one there to hang the cross. It indicates that the team member has little or no prayer support in the community.

Now start preparing yourself for the weekend, and it makes no difference what position you have been asked to fill on the weekend, they are all important.

Between the time you are called and the weekend make sure you are at the center for other weekends – spend some time in the Main Palanca Chapel so you at least know where it is. Know where the various rooms are – the Service Team Room, the conference room, the candidates lounge, the secondary palanca chapels, the kitchen, the north cafeteria, the north chapel, the various storage rooms – make yourself familiar with all of these. If you don't know where they are, ask a fellow team member, the board rep or the rector/rectora.

Seek spiritual guidance or counseling if you feel a need for it (I need it constantly) and **don't** do this on the weekend. Remember that time for spiritual guidance should be reserved for the candidates not the team. Leave your problems at home for the weekend.

I guess I'm just getting to be an old fuss-budget but I recall that when I began working in the Cursillo Movement in Arizona **no one** was allowed on a team in any capacity until they had attended a Leader's School. I thought that was a very hard stance and expecting a lot – but recently I have seen and heard things that are convincing me that it was justified. And I am reminded that we all get so much out of Cursillo and Jesus says in scripture, "When much has been given a man, much will be required of him. More will be asked of a man to whom more has been entrusted." Luke 12:48
