Yesterday I observed our feline friend lounging in the middle of the empty lot across the street looking very contented. *Lesson: Enjoy each day the Lord gives you and treasure the opportunity to rejoice in the beauty of His creation. After all He made it for us.*

After one visit with Stymie when he rubbed against David's leg, David noticed a tick on his leg. Then it happened a second time. *Lesson: Sometimes even good friends can inadvertently hurt you but that doesn't mean they shouldn't be forgiven or loved. Only God will never disappoint us, let us down or make a mistake.*

A question in my Catechism lessons when I was little was "Why did God make me?" And the answer is imbedded in my mind and now my heart. "God made me to know Him, to love Him and to serve Him." In my search to know Him, to learn the Truth that is God in my life, I have encountered His presence in many places - in the awesomeness of the Grand Canyon, in the imagination of an artist's eye, in the soaring notes of a song that touched my soul, in the loving hugs of family and friends, in the inspiration of a writers mind, in the Good News found in the Holy Bible, and in the soft purr of a black cat named Stymie.

"Thanks, God. Keep teaching me, and I will try to keep learning your lessons of love."
