Ephphatha!!!

Dear Cursillo Family,

"... then He looked up to heaven... and said to him, "Ephphatha!" (that is, "Be opened!). And [immediately] the man's ears were opened, ..., and he spoke plainly." Mark 7:34-35

Jesus is calling us to "two way" communication. He has blessed us with ears to hear truth and mouths to speak it. When God speaks to us, he issues an SOS, that is, He speaks to us through Scripture, Others and Signs. For communication to occur, we must be "open" to His message and His methods. When He speaks, do you respond: "Here I am Lord" or "Speak, Lord, I'm listening." How do you speak to God? How do you pray? When asked this question, Mother Teresa replied: "I don't say anything, I listen."

Openness is a precondition for all good communication. The Cursillo family benefits from open "two way" communication. DISCOVERING AND CELEBRATING

My husband says sometimes my behavior is kind of dizzy. Well, this last month I had a good excuse for being that way! After a couple weeks of sinus dizzy symptoms that wouldn't go away I went to the doctor and found out I had an inner ear infection. I also had little episodes of vertigo which would really make my world spin. Interestingly, I found out there are little calcium crystals that can form in your ear and either the infection or that knock on the head I got falling down outside shook some loose, messing up my inner ear and causing the vertigo.

Now you are probably saying, "Where in the heck is she going with this one?" Hang in there, I'm getting closer. I also learned about a procedure done in physical therapy which involves turning your head in certain positions that channels the crystals out of the ear canals and into a reservoir where the body gets rid of them. What were ways to keep my spirit invigorated, my heart strong and true, my eyes healthy and able to recognize Him at work in my day, my ears finely tuned to His messages of love ect.?

Whoa, my mind started popping out possibilities! At the top of the list was Group Reunion. It has kept me on the path these last 16 yrs. and most importantly moving forward. My Group was there when my mother died, my husband had heart problems, and my granddaughter had surgery at 2 ½ months. They are there to laugh with me when I feel like laughing and rejoice with me at little and big accomplishments of my children, my husband, myself. We pray together, learn together, question, support, and encourage each other - Jesus' team in training, exercising our spiritual body.
