DISCOVERING AND CELEBRATING

When my 2 year old grandson, Conner, gets something he has asked for, he will on occasion respond with “Tinku” (“thank you” in 2yr.old lingo). Since the ladies Cursillo in November, which had a theme of praising and thanking God, I have constantly run into the concept of being grateful. It’s nothing I didn’t know already, just my awareness being sharpened a bit more.

I read an article in a woman’s magazine on the subject of happiness that stressed those who were thankful for their life, and the people in it were more content. At a graveside service my husband and I attended last month for a friend’s mother, the minister shared how the mother embraced her life - both the good and the bad. The daughter thanked each of us with a hug for coming to celebrate her mother’s life with tears in her eyes. Like mother, like daughter.

In the Bible Study I am in now, we are covering the travels of Paul and the hardships in his ministry. At one point Paul is thrown into prison and he immediately has a praise service. Most of us didn’t know if that would be our first response. The speaker on the video asked us, “What is your prison; how do you praise God in that?” That was really a thought provoking question for me.

1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 reads, “Rejoice always, pray constantly, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.” It was pointed out that Paul says to rejoice and give thanks in all circumstances not for them; that when we put our focus on God and all the good he has done for us it puts our circumstances in perspective. Our joy is not dependent on what is happening in our lives but on what God is doing in our lives - a lot to be grateful for.

As this New Year begins with a calendar full of possibilities ahead of me, with hopes, wishes, plans and goals in my mind I think about what I would like this year to hold. I think the most important would be Gratitude - for each day filled with God’s blessing; to embrace all of it, praise God for His love in it, and pass it on to others.
