MESSAGE FROM YOUR LAY DIRECTOR

Hello Cursillo Family -

We had a great work day in May with around 25 cursillistas who volunteered most of their day to do some things at the retreat center to benefit the entire family. All of the air conditioners have been checked and cleaned for the upcoming "hot" season; our new store room is being painted; the copy machine room was cleaned and made more user friendly; the closet in the vestibule was cleaned with many things removed to allow for better organization; and, the pews in the main chapel were all washed. There is still much to be accomplished, but if we all work as a team, eventually we can tackle another "need." I want to thank all those who were able to participate in this cleaning day. God knows who you are, and best of all - HE WILL REWARD YOU.

Just as a reminder, at the closing of any weekend - please leave the songbooks stacked on the inside isle of each pew rather than returning them to the vestibule closet. Those books that are used in the North chapel can be stacked on the window sills of the main alter on the South side. Our candles used for candlelight should always be returned in the plastic containers to the vestibule closet. Any song sheets should be stacked according to names of song and left in the vestibule. This will allow for that music to be available for the next weekend, if needed. Within a reasonable amount of time, they will be thrown away if no longer needed.

It is important, if you choose to serve meals, that you contact a food service team member to sign up to serve. It is necessary for the team members to have a head count of those they will be expecting to show up to serve. There is a limited number of servers they can accept, so sign up early so you can get your name on the list.

Dave Hummel has volunteered to head a committee to clean the conference room at the closing of each weekend. THANK YOU DAVE. You have no idea what a huge help it is to have people volunteer to do a job of such magnitude.
