## Rollista Rule Change Effective with September Weekend

Several years ago the rules governing who qualified to be a rollista were changed to require a person to be an auxiliary twice before being a rollista. This was due to large number of people in the rollista file and a small number in the auxiliary file.

Now the Cursillo Board, faced with a shortage of persons eligible to be rollistas, has revised the requirement. The new requirement is that you "must be an auxiliary at least once" prior to being a rollista. This means you could be asked to be a rollista even though you have been an auxiliary only once. However, anyone asked to do so may decline and choose to be an auxiliary twice.

## From the Lay Director's Notebook

### It's Not My Responsibility -- Or is it?

Recent lapses in completion of candidate applications on the part of sponsors, and the number and type of calls being received by the Candidate Applications Committee leads me to believe that a fair number of Cursillistas are either not aware of the sponsor's responsibilities, or choose to ignore them. Whatever the reason, it might be good to review those responsibilities.

A sponsor is expected to ensure that the candidate is aware that the weekend is a Catholic experience even though members of other Christian faiths are welcome and may be present.

Escorting the candidate to the weekend, showing him or her around and attending to the needs of the candidate's family during the weekend are part of the responsibilities.

The sponsor is expected to perform some form of serious palanca and to have a palanca letter for the candidate detailing their palanca. (The palanca chart will be there on Thursday night so a sponsor can sign-up to pray in the palanca chapel.)

Limiting contact with the candidate during the weekend, in other words **no serving of meals during the weekend the candidate (or spouse or family member) attends.**

Presence at the Sponsor's Hour (Thursday), the Apostolic Hour (Saturday at 8:00 PM) and the closing (Sunday at 5:00 PM) is also a part of sponsoring.

Make sure that the candidate sponsored gets into a group reunion and follow up to see how the candidate is fairing in his or her fourth day.

If the candidate selected cannot attend the weekend for which accepted, the sponsor should notify the Applications Committee so that the spot vacated may be offered to another candidate.

Now we all knew those things didn't we? I'll bet the callers just forgot them. Then again maybe their sponsors never told them all about them. I know they wouldn't choose to ignore them, no real Cursillista would. Oh, by the way, these are just the basics. Check out the Sponsor's Responsibilities on the web site or in the holder by the bulletin board at the south entrance to the Retreat Center.
